A *Holt Island Nature Reserve, opposite the Waits*

Entry by Thicket Path behind the Parish Church, this island has a significant history of cultivation of willow plantations for harvesting of willow wands for the local basket making factory.

Open Sat & Sun 10am to 4pm. Sunday Basket Weaving Demo.

B *The Parish Church of All Saints*

This C15th Church, one of the "1000 Best Parish Churches", with a Comper Screen & photos of the WWI aircraft crash in 1918.

Open Saturday 11am – 5pm Sunday 2pm – 4pm, cream teas available from 3pm

C *The Methodist Church, The Waits*

Built in 1904, close to where John Wesley preached in 1774. Exhibition of photographs of all Church activities now in the Church collection. Please bring any you may have, to share.

Open Saturday 10 am - 4 pm, Sunday 12 noon - 4 pm.

D *The Norris Museum, the Broadway*

Among the activities at the museum will be the chance to handle some very interesting (and possibly odd) objects from the collection. Also, on Saturday 21st, there will be a Family Trail and a children's Make & Take corner.

E *Muslim Prayer and Education Centre, The Broadway*

Previously the North Hunts Constitutional Club which was built in 1891 on the site of the old Unicorn Inn.

Open Saturday & Sunday. 10 am - 4 pm

F *The Bridge Chapel*

This early 15th Century Chapel, with its fascinating past, is open.

G *The Corn Exchange, The Pavement*

Grade II Listed. Built in 1864; large scale, sensitive internal renovation in 2010. Now a versatile events venue and community hub. Compelling gallery of historical photographs.

Saturday and Sunday 10am – 2pm

H *The Free Church, Market Hill*

This "Non-Conformist Cathedral", built in 1864, its interior was reconstructed in 1980.

refreshments until 2pm
Sunday 1.30 pm – 4 pm

I *The Town Council Chambers, Market Hill*

This 1850 Victorian House is now home to the Town Council; up the Grand Staircase to the first floor Council Chamber to see the Civic Regalia.

J *Faizan Medina Mosque, 22 Needingworth Road*

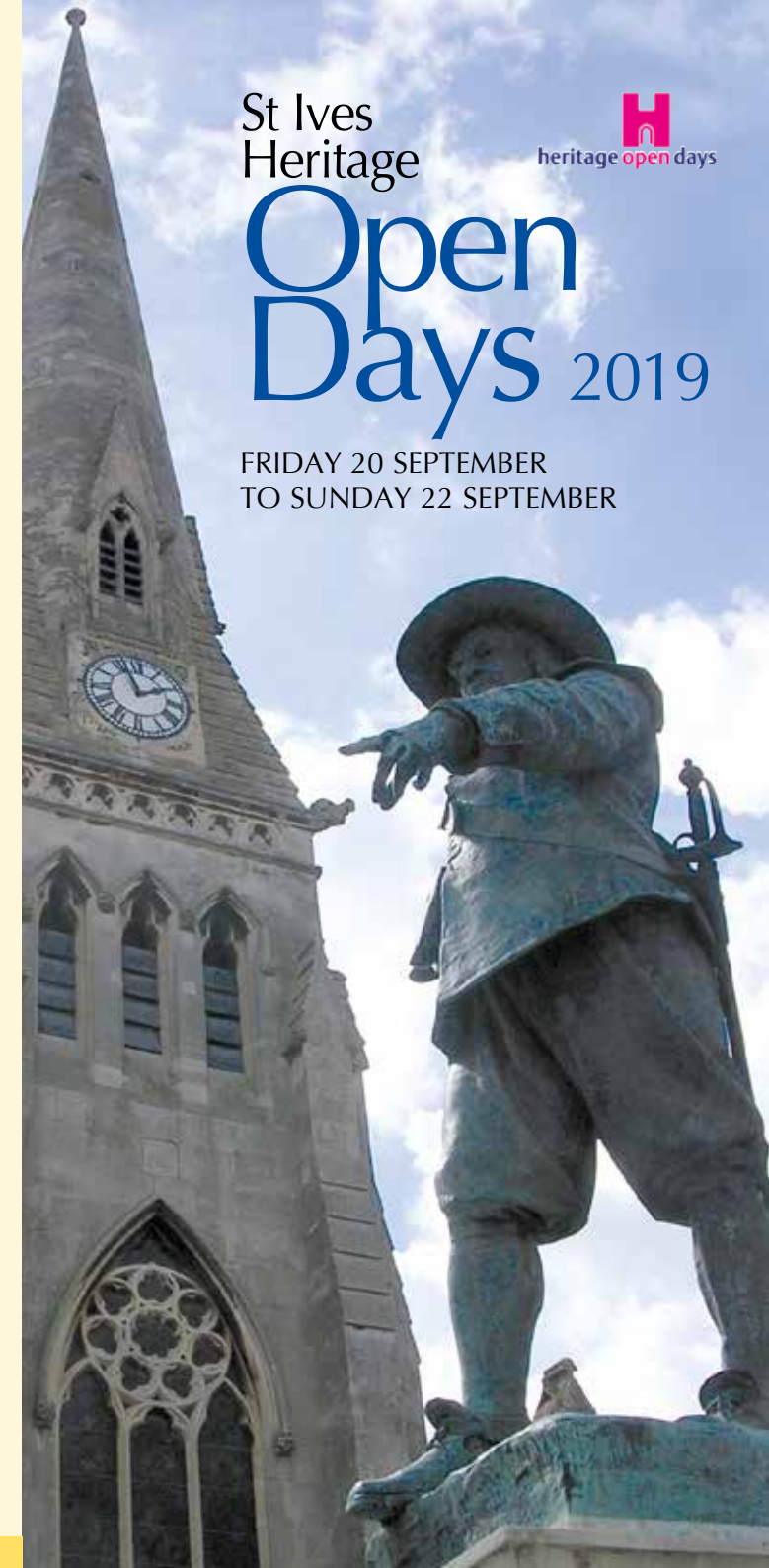

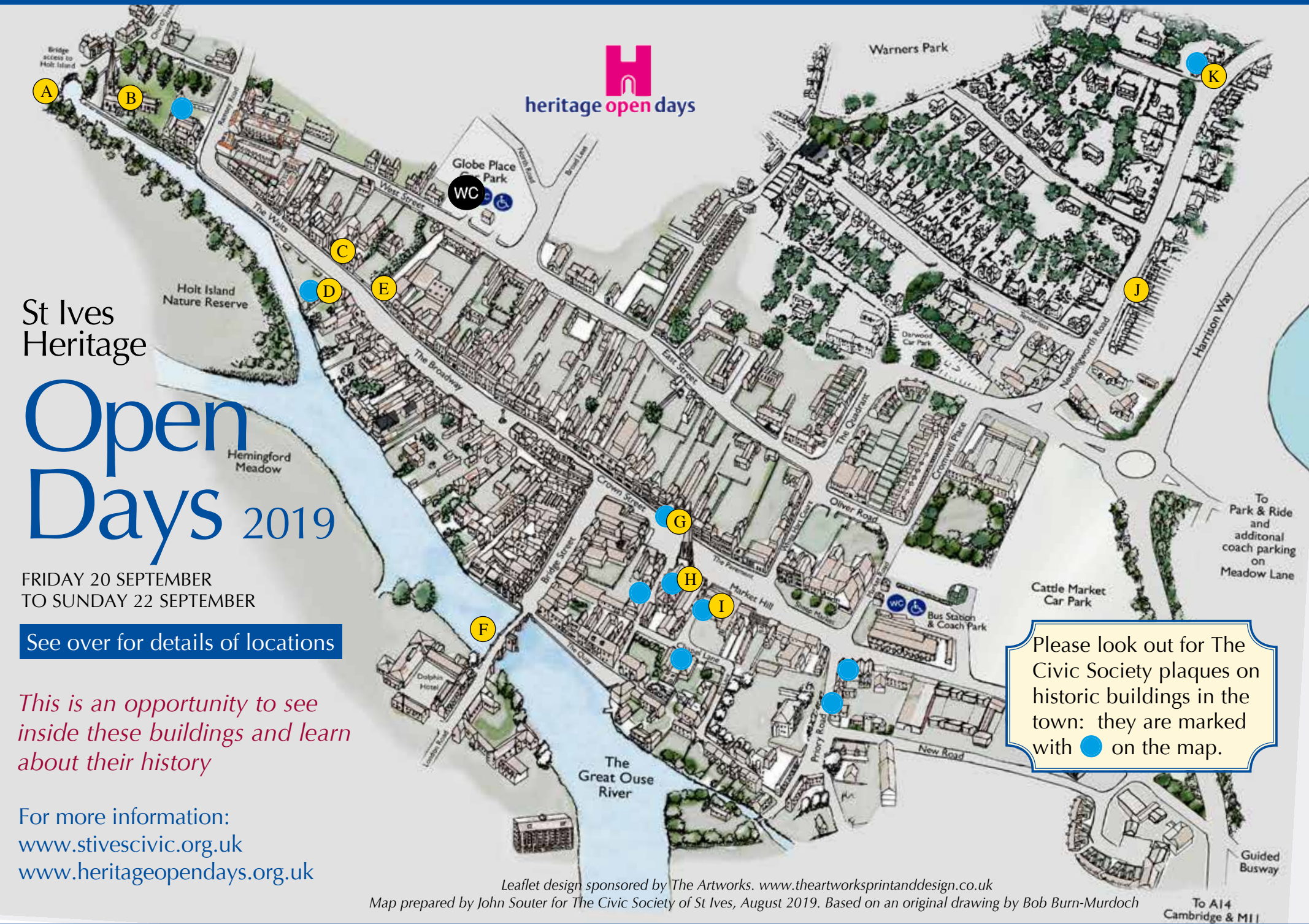
