

TOWN HALL PIAZZA PLAN.

This is a layout suggested by Mr. Chris Lewis of St. Ives and shows there could be an alternative to Options 1 and 2 without moving the war memorial and the Cromwell Statue, and having an open space in the centre of Market Hill. It is superimposed on the existing layout.

The central feature is a piazza in front of the Town Hall, Golden Lion and Free Church with turning space at the western end of Market Hill.

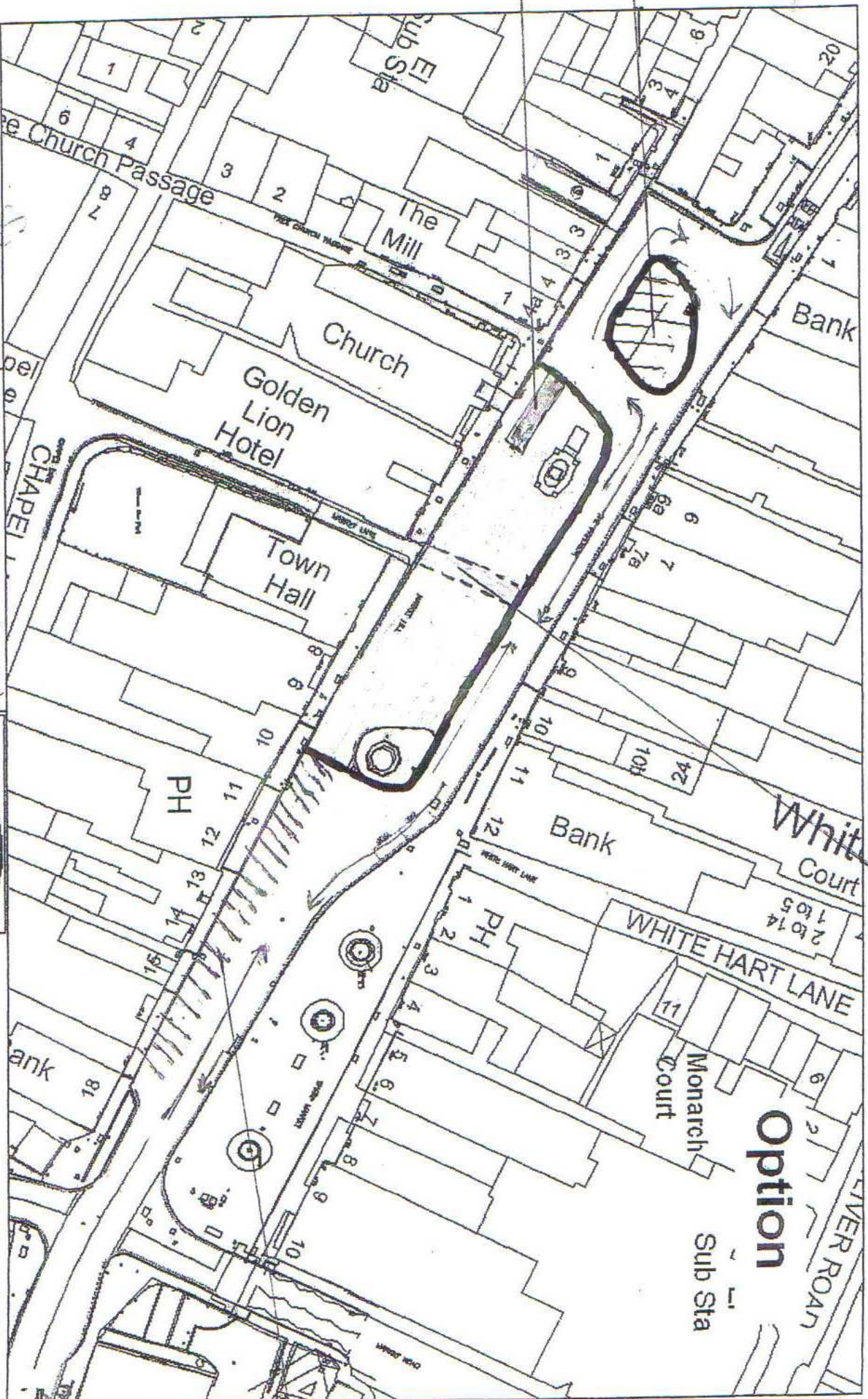
The chevron parking provides about as many spaces as at present.

KEY:

- A. Single track across the piazza to Chapel Street, indicated by a different surface or dotted lines.**
- B. Parking for 20 – 24 vehicles.**
- C. Mixed vehicle and pedestrian area outside the Free Church door.**
- D. ‘Shaved-off’ configuration to allow for large vehicles turning.**
