What will St Ives look like in 2068?

Use your imagination in any of these ways.....

Written - maximum of 1000 words e.g. prose, poetry, story.

2D Image - maximum size A3 e.g. painting, collage, sketch, embroidery, photograph, mixed media.

3D Image - maximum size A2 e.g. Lego, sculpture, wood, 3D print, play dough, papier mache.

Video - maximum length 5 minutes e.g. spoken, animation, sung.

Competition ends 6th September 2018 Please register before 1st September.

- There is no age restriction and no entry fee.
- Individual age groups: Under 5 yrs, 5 - 6 yrs, 7 - 9 yrs, 10 - 11 yrs, 12 - 13 yrs, 14 - 16 yrs, 17 - 18 yrs, 19 +
- Primary schools may enter Key Stage 1 or Key Stage 2 categories
- Groups will be classed as Youth Groups or Groups e.g. Scouts, WI, Rowing Club.

You may enter more than one piece, each entry **must** have name, age or group and contact details clearly and securely attached.

There will be an Exhibition of entries in the Free Church on Friday 7th September from 12 to 6 p.m. and Saturday 8th September from 10 to 4 p.m. The winning entries will be on display at the Norris Museum from Monday 10th to Saturday 22nd September.

Entries **must** be delivered to the Free Church on Thursday 6th September 2018 between 12 noon and 7 p.m. and collected on Saturday 8th September between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. Winning entries will be taken by the Civic Society to the Norris Museum.
